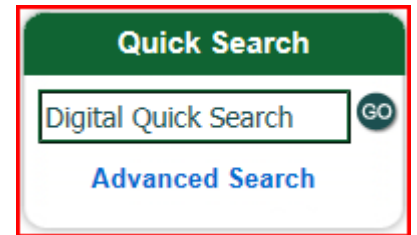


# eBooks for Kindle Fire

**Step 1:** If you have downloaded the Camden Public Library app, you can open it to find the link to “Download ebooks and audiobooks”.

If you don't have the app (it's free!), tap “Web” from the home screen and go to <http://download.maineinfolnet.org>



- Use the Quick Search or
- Click **Advanced Search** and then choose **Kindle Book** in the **Format** drop-down box.
- Select the eBook you want and **Add to Cart** or **Place a Hold**. (you may the check box at the bottom of Advanced Search to “**Only show titles with copies available**”).

If the eBook is available, click **Add to Cart**.




If the eBook is already checked out, click **Place a Hold**, provide your email address, and OverDrive will notify you when it is available.

## Step 2: Check out the eBooks to your library account.

- When you have added eBooks into your cart, click **Proceed to Checkout**.
- Sign in and select **Camden Public Library** from the list under C. Type your library card number at the prompt. For the Camden Public Library, this is the **barcode** on the back of the card.

- At the **Check-Out screen**, select 7 or 14 day loan period from the drop-down menu, and then click **Confirm to Check Out**. (You may set your default to 14 days in **My Account**.)

### Step 3: Download your eBook to your Kindle Fire.

- Once you have checked out your eBook, **click the**  **button** which will open a new browser window for the Amazon Public Library Loan web page.
- You will be prompted to login to your Amazon.com account or create a new account .To register a Kindle, select **Manage Your Kindle**, then **Manage Your Devices**, then **Register a Kindle**. Your Kindle will now have a name, for example, “Mike’s Kindle”.
- From green box to the right choose your device from the **Deliver to** menu, and then click **Get library book** to send the book to your Kindle Fire via a **Wifi** connection. 
- From your Home screen, tap Books. If you do not see your title, click the settings **Gear** icon  in the top-right corner of the **Home** screen. Tap **Sync**. Start reading by tapping the book cover for the title. Currently, there is no page numeration for Kindle Fire, but this may be updated in the near future.

### Due Dates and Returns

- Your eBook is **due** either 7 or 14 days, depending on the option you chose at the check-out screen. Amazon will notify you and the eBook is then no longer readable.
- You can check in the eBook early to be eligible to check out another eBook (3 eBooks max). Go to your Amazon account; choose **Manage Your Kindle**, then **Your Kindle Library**. Click the menu next to the eBook you want to return and select **Return this book**. If you return an eBook early, a **Loan Ended** notification will appear on that item in your Kindle booklist.

### Things to Remember

- For the **Kindle Fire** you do **NOT** need a computer. Tap **Web** and use the built-in web browser to navigate to the **Maine InfoNet Download Library** website (<http://download.maineinfonet.org>.)
- You may edit certain settings (lending period, saved titles, etc.) under **My Account** at the **Maine InfoNet Download Library**
- Remember to **Sync** the device to get the Kindle eBook(s) to load on the device.
- Amazon offers Whispersync technology to preserve your notes and last page read if you decide to check out the same title later or purchase the eBook from the Kindle store. To retain this information, make sure your **Settings > Annotations Backup** is turned **on**. If you do not want to retain that information, turn it **off**.

- Please place holds on books that you are interested in reading. The number of holds on a given title helps decide if additional copies of a title should be purchased.
