In 2022, your library was named the **only Five-Star Library in Maine!** Based on 2020 data, the rankings were the first to include COVID-19's impact on programs and services. This honor places the CPL among the nation's top 85 libraries and marks its 15th straight year as a Star Library.

Conjuring everyday library magic

One of the best parts of my morning is the moment when the library doors first swing open and the people of our town stroll through the entrance. The library instantly lights up as a gathering place where all are welcome – no matter their age, beliefs, or situation. Here, the everyday magic of serving important human needs is a constant. Here's what I mean:

- As parents and toddlers arrive for Story Time, a lasting friendship with the written word – and the stories we all share – begins.
- Amid the quiet of the Reading Room, a lifelong learner opens a laptop and begins typing the memoir she has always wanted to write.
- Our Homebound Delivery librarian visits with an avid reader who shares how valuable reading is to his quality of life, strengthening a vital social connection.

- Later in the day, middle-schoolers burst in to choose the books that define their interests before retreating into the library's warmth and safety.

On a daily basis, we strive to meet our neighbors' needs, offering vigorous adult and children's learning opportunities, free streaming films, guided access to historical resources, and one-on-one career help – to name a few.

Our Five-Star library remains a constant for our community – an anchor that reliably serves in a time of so much change, and it will continue to keep the light alive for the generations to come.

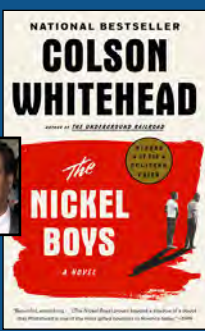

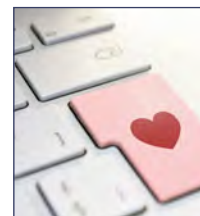

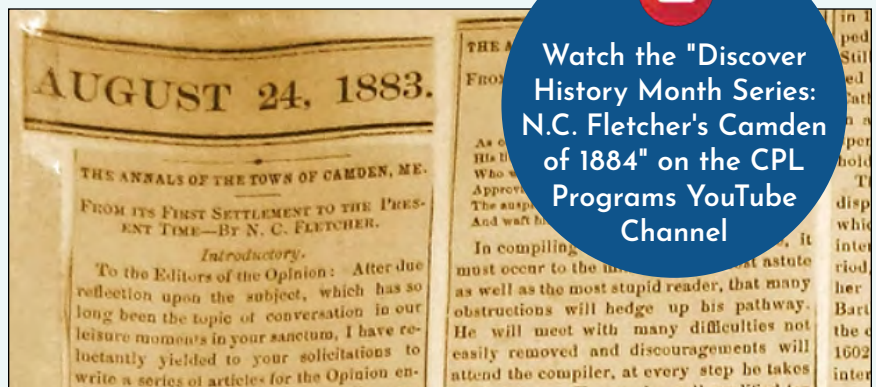

Quite a Catch: *Camden Herald* Archives

Our goal is to offer the richness of history through the most immediate media of the day. This historic newspaper offers a rare, intimate glimpse into everyday life decades ago. The impact of making this record available to everyone is immense. Researchers, historians, students, and educators, at any grade level or degree level, will benefit.



N.C. Fletcher: Eyewitness to Camden history

The Walsh History Center produces an annual exhibit in the library's Jean Picker Room. This year's exhibit and history talk were on Camden's own N.C. Fletcher. Fletcher was a Universalist minister who preached all over the Midcoast for three decades in the early 1800s. He became a businessman in 1854,

starting in the lime industry and settling into being a pharmacist for the remainder of his career. He also served in the state legislature and on the Governor's Council. He knew everyone worth knowing – and wrote an eyewitness history of Camden in 1883 and 1884.

Constantly unfolding beauty of historic parks attracts scores of citizens



In 2022, the Camden Amphitheatre and Harbor Park were busier than ever with events for the public to enjoy. They started with Winterfest in February, featuring ice carving, a doggy fashion show, and a polar plunge, then came a concert by the Midcoast Community Chorus in May. Shakespeare performances throughout the summer numbered 17, and we hosted 18 weddings, May through October.

Other events included engaging performances by the P2P Dance Center, Downeast Singers, Bay Winds North Wind Ensemble, and

Mondaynight Jazz Orchestra. Also on the list were the Maine Outdoor Film Festival; the Camden Rotary Club Fourth of July Concerts; Miss Amy's Story Time; and morning Yoga and Tai Chi classes.

For the first time in three years, the Camden Amphitheatre and Harbor Park were filled with arts and crafts enthusiasts visiting vendors for Harbor Arts & Books in June and October.

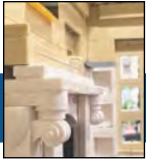
The Amphitheatre and library grounds were a stop on the Camden Garden Club annual

garden tour in July. Guests were guided around the parks, once in the morning and again in the afternoon.

The Bay Chamber Screen Door Festival featured three to five concerts a day during five days and was well attended.

Special events included Camden on Canvas, the Stewardship Educational Alliance's Environmental Fair (S.E.A.), the Gay Parade in June, plus a Native Plant Sale in September.
