Miss Amy continues following the monarchs and their development on her Lincolnville Farm.

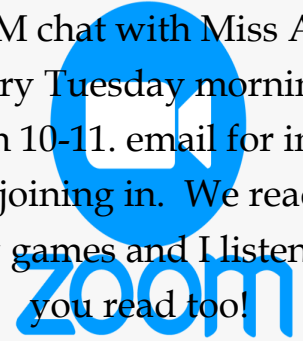

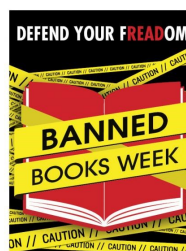
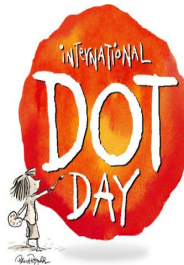


Join Miss Amy via Zoom on Wednesdays; at 4:00 for creative art projects and journaling tips for teens and adults.
